## Director's Report:

Executive Director Rogers updated the Board about the status of the new property and the status of the selection of Architectural and Engineering services. She stated that the committee selected Spring Engineering, Inc. as the recommended firm to enter into contract negotiations. After some discussion, Commissioner Cox made a motion to move forward with the recommendation from the committee and select Spring Engineering, Inc as the design team for the campus build-out project. Commissioner Evans seconded. Motion carried.

Executive Director Rogers updated the Commissioners on the digital office solutions progress. She explained that the District has signed an agreement with Insperity for payroll and HR functions, and DocuPhase for the accounts payable function.
